<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✧ Designed targeted questionnaires for students in Grades 4 to 6 and distributed it to 530 participators in 4 non-governmental primary and middle schools in Guangzhou, for a purpose of assessing the difficulty of school adaptability of rural families' children and offer the applicable recommendations.</li><li>✧ Discovered that 31.7% of migrant workers' children stayed in their present school no more than a year or transferred to another school regularly; determined main factors that had a significant impact on children's educational adaptability from family upbringing, school upbringing with interpersonal relationship, and children's involvement in and interests for NGO's targeted activities.</li><li>✧ Conducted face-to-face interviews with principals and class advisors from selected primary schools and presented investigation results via Chi-Square Test, SPSS, pie charts and bar graphs; resulted in justifying top four reasons that have caused such problems for children from children's psychological factors, family environment, school education, and education policy of local government.</li><li>✧ Built up constructive feedback in unifying family, school, government and NGO's advantage to support and better children's adaptability in attending local schools.</li><li>✧ Research recognized and adopted by Guangzhou Youth Volunteer Association.</li><li>✧ Sparked ongoing co-op internship opportunities between NGO and School of Politics and Public Administration in GDUFS as a result of this research paper.</li><li>✧ Awarded by Undergraduate Innovation Experimentation Project at Guangdong Province (UIRP) as the best panel with RMB 6,000 Yuan as research grant.</li></ul>
